

Directions for use:



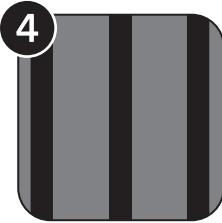
1 Clean the mounting surface using a dry and dirt free cloth



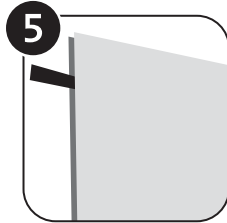
2 Wipe the mounting surface with 50:50 mixture of IPA & water, followed by a dry wipe



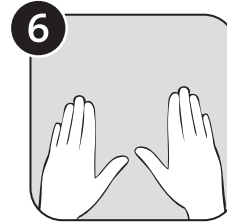
3 Apply Tite-R-Bond™ 2684A onto the mounting surface with a clean cloth and allow to dry for 5 minutes



4 Apply Norton Mirror Mounting Tape vertically and apply pressure using roller



5 Peel off liner and stick after aligning edges



6 Hold the mirror for 10 minutes. Mechanical support at the bottom is recommended for at least 4 hours after mounting, to ensure long term bond strength
